USER GUIDE eyes³ CAMERA - Recording Device ¹ eyes³

- 1. Place the Recording Devices around the Court (see Recording Device Placement)
- 2. Start eyes³ CAMERA and START Recording

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USER GUIDE Assign eyes³ CAMERA Group ¹ eyes³

- 1. Physically place Recording Devices around the Court (see Physical Setup)
- 2. Create new CAMERA Group via MATCH Control (as required)
- 3. Assign "CAMERA Group"

USER GUIDE Recording Device Focus



For best results, ensure that the recording image is correctly focused.

Touch the area to lock the camera focus (indicated by a green square). The square changes colour to red when focus lock is achieved.

It is imperative to ensure that the Recording Devices do not move during operation (this includes interference from players, spectators, etc., whether inadvertently or not). Any movement in the Recording Devices will result in a shift in the CAMERA perspective resulting in an out-of-CALIBRATION situation affecting the accuracy of the CHALLENGE Result.

The following procedures **must** be followed to minimise out-of-CALIBRATION situations:

- Ensure ALL moving parts of the Recording Device mounting accessories are securely fastened during the physical setup process
- Ensure that the Recording Devices are not interfered with during operation
- Investigate Recording Device movement alerts issued by eyes³ CONTROL, if any
- Monitor via the Snapshot + Verify functions the CALIBRATION status of each Recording Device via eyes³ CONTROL regularly, and re-CALIBRATE as required



eyes³ APP requires Internet connectivity to operate. All Recording Devices and eyes³ CONTROL Device must be connected to the Internet either via WI-FI or mobile broadband.

Performance of the system will depend heavily on the following:

- bandwidth and speed of the Internet connectivity
- stability of the Internet connectivity
- diversity of mobile broadband providers used by the Recording Devices (if mobile broadband is used)
- mobile broadband plan is active with adequate available data (i.e. not expired)

{tip} Test the Internet connectivity speed when appropriate.

USER GUIDE Appendix - Auto Re-start APP 'v eyes^{3®}

For operational efficiency, it is recommended that eyes³ CAMERA auto re-start function is enabled. This function enables eyes³ CAMERA to automatically re-start if necessary.

In eyes³ CAMERA recording mode:

- 1. press the Recording Device's Home Button three (3) times to START 'Guided Access'
- 2. repeat press the Recording Device's Home Button three (3) times to STOP 'Guided Access' {you will need the Recording Device's PIN to proceed}

USER GUIDE Appendix - Conserve Battery Life ' eyes^{3®}

To minimise battery drain, whenever the Recording Devices are not deployed or are being stored, certain settings in the Recording Devices are recommended; including the ones illustrated below.



Avoid activating or running applications/functions that has a high battery drain, such as:

- 1. Screen on High Brightness
- 2. Always-on Screen Time (i.e. Auto-Lock set to NEVER)
- 3. Connectivity Setting ON (Wi-Fi, Bluetooth, Personal Hotspot, etc.)
- 4. Camera/Video Recording
